NEW MEMBER:

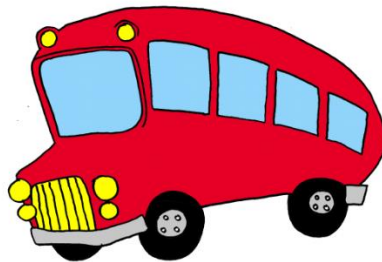
